





Front up score on dotted lines. Fold and burnish each line, Optional destress ink edges.







Cut 3, Optional Ink




Cut the red sections out. Glue the green flaps together. Please reference video.












As shown below, take the front cover and glue it to the larger pieces.






Fold top left corner down as shown.







Fold top right corner down as shown.




Glue the folded sections down and add notch if desired
